**INTERNATIONAL
ACADEMIC INTERCHANGE AGREEMENT**

between

AUBURN UNIVERSITY

and

SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY, EGYPT

AUBURN UNIVERSITY, Auburn, Alabama, USA, and SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY, Ismalia, Egypt, wishing to develop cooperative relations on the basis of established contacts and mutual understandings, especially to develop academic and cultural interchange through mutual assistance in the areas of education and research, agree as follows:

**PART I
Area of Cooperation**

The area of cooperation includes, subject to mutual consent and appropriate conditions, any program offered at either university and proposed by either as desirable, feasible, and contributory to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

**PART II
Methods**

All understandings and assistance shall be subject to availability of funds and the specific approval of the President of AUBURN UNIVERSITY and of the President of SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY, through such activities or programs as:

1. Exchange of faculty members and technical staff
2. Exchange of students
3. Conduct joint research activities
4. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
5. Special short-term academic programs
6. Cultural exchange activities
7. Joint participation in international training courses
8. Provide for graduate and undergraduate coursework at Auburn University
9. Provide opportunities for staff development for both universities by participation in sabbatical leave and other personnel development programs

10. Engage in consultancies
11. Other activities as deemed mutually appropriate.

The terms of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each program and activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular activity or program. Furthermore it is understood that each institution will enter into specific program by program written agreements as required for compliance with the respective immigration regulations of the parties involved. Each university will designate a Liaison/Contact Officer to develop specific activities or programs for approval of the respective presidents.

PART III
Effective Date and Length of Agreement

This agreement will remain in force for a period of five years subject to the availability of funds, and any amendment and/or modification of this agreement requires a written approval of the President of AUBURN UNIVERSITY and that of the President of SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY and shall be appended hereto. After the initial five-year period, this agreement may be renewed by mutual written consent.

Either party reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon six (6) months written notice to the other. Any individual activities to be continued will be specifically identified and provided for at the time of termination.


Each party shall be responsible for assuring full compliance by its participants with applicable laws and regulations, including insurance, of the respective nations.

Nothing contained herein or in the activities conducted hereunder shall constitute either party the agent, servant or employee of the other party, and each party shall be fully and solely responsible for its own actions and obligations.


This agreement shall take effect on the date of final signature indicated below and IN WITNESS WHEREOF; the parties hereto have offered their signatures:



INTERNATIONAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
COLLEGE OF FISHERY WEALTH, SUEZ CANAL UNIVERSITY (EGYPT)
AND
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, AUBURN UNIVERSITY (USA)

This agreement is made and entered into this 9th day of Feb 2010, by and between College of Agriculture, Auburn University, USA and College of Fishery Wealth, Suez Canal University, Egypt.

WHEREAS, Auburn University and Suez Canal University desire to engage in cooperative educational and research activities, for the mutual benefit of both institutions, the parties have agreed upon the following:

1. The parties will jointly develop cooperative educational and research programs for faculty and students of the two institutions within the framework of this agreement.
2. The cooperative activities to be covered by this agreement will include faculty and student exchanges, study abroad, collaborative research programs, seminars and workshops, and service programs.
3. Each activity to be performed under this agreement will be undertaken pursuant to an addendum which will contain the specific terms and conditions governing the activity. These terms and conditions will be mutually agreed upon by the two institutions on a case by case basis.
4. Each institution will be responsible for seeking funds to support its involvement in the cooperative activities contemplated under this agreement, and all such activities will be dependent upon the budgetary appropriations of the parties.
5. This agreement will be in effect for a period of five (5) years from the date of execution, and it may be renewed for additional five (5) year periods by the parties. This agreement may be terminated by either party's giving ninety (90) days written notice to the other party, provided, however, that such termination will not affect the completion of any activity underway at the time that the notice of termination is given.
6. All modifications to this agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.
