

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**ADEKUNLE AJASIN UNIVERSITY**

AUBURN UNIVERSITY, Auburn, USA and ADEKUNLE AJASIN UNIVERSITY, Akungba Akoko, Ondo State, Nigeria, wishing to develop cooperative relations on the basis of established contacts and mutual understandings, especially to develop academic and cultural interchange through mutual assistance in the areas of education and research agree as follows:

**PART I**  
**Area of Cooperation**

The areas of cooperation includes subject to mutual consent and appropriate conditions, any programme offered at either university and proposed by either as desirable, feasible and contributory to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

**PART II**  
**Methods**

All understanding and assistance shall be subject to availability of funds and the specific approval of the Dean of the College of Agriculture of AUBURN UNIVERSITY and the Vice Chancellor of ADEKUNLE AJASIN UNIVERSITY, through such activities or programs as:

1. Exchange of faculty members and technical staff
2. Exchange of students
3. Conduct of joint research activities
4. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
5. Special short-term academic programs
6. Cultural exchange activities
7. Joint participation in international training course
8. Provide for graduate and undergraduate course at Auburn University
9. Provide opportunities for staff development for both university participation
10. Engage in consultancies
11. Other activities as deemed mutually appropriate

The terms of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each programme and activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular activity or programme. Furthermore it is understood that each

institution will enter into specific programme by programme written agreement as required for compliance with the respective immigration regulations of the parties involved. Each University will designate a Liaison/Contact Officer to develop specific activities or programmes for the approval of respective presidents.

**PART III**  
**Effective Date and Length of Agreement**

This agreement will remain in force for a period of five years subject to the availability of funds and any amendment and/or modification of this agreement requires a written approval of the Dean of the College of Agriculture of Auburn University and that of the Vice Chancellor of Adekunle Ajasin University and shall be appended hereto. After the initial five years, this agreement may be renewed by mutual written consent.

Either party reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon six (6) months written notice to the other. Any individual activities to be continued will be specifically identified and provided for at the time of termination.


Each party shall be responsible for assuring full compliance by its participant with applicable laws and regulations, including insurance, of the respective nations.

This agreement shall take effect on the date of final signature indicated below and IN WITNESS WHEREOF; the parties hereto have offered their signatures;


