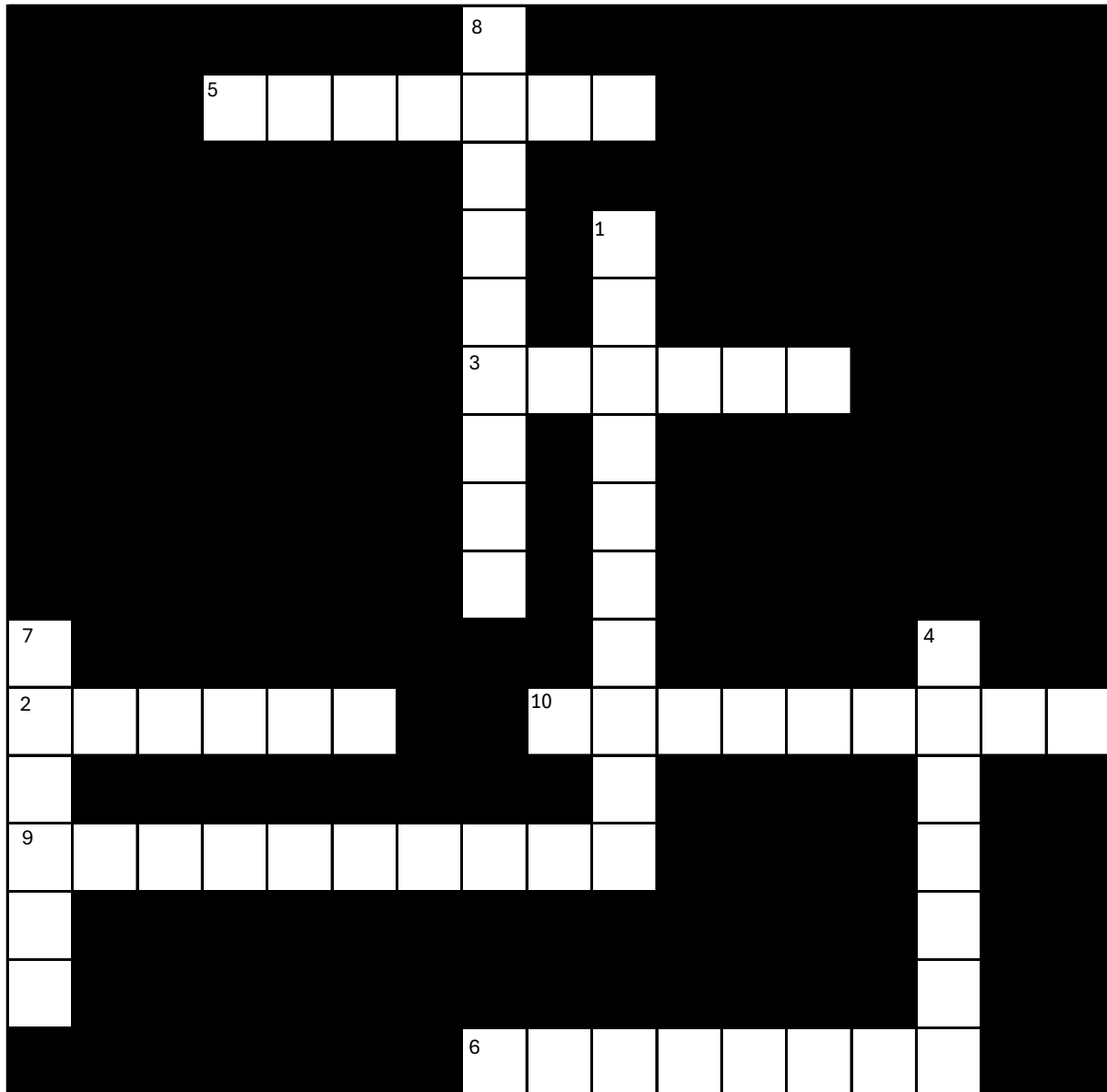
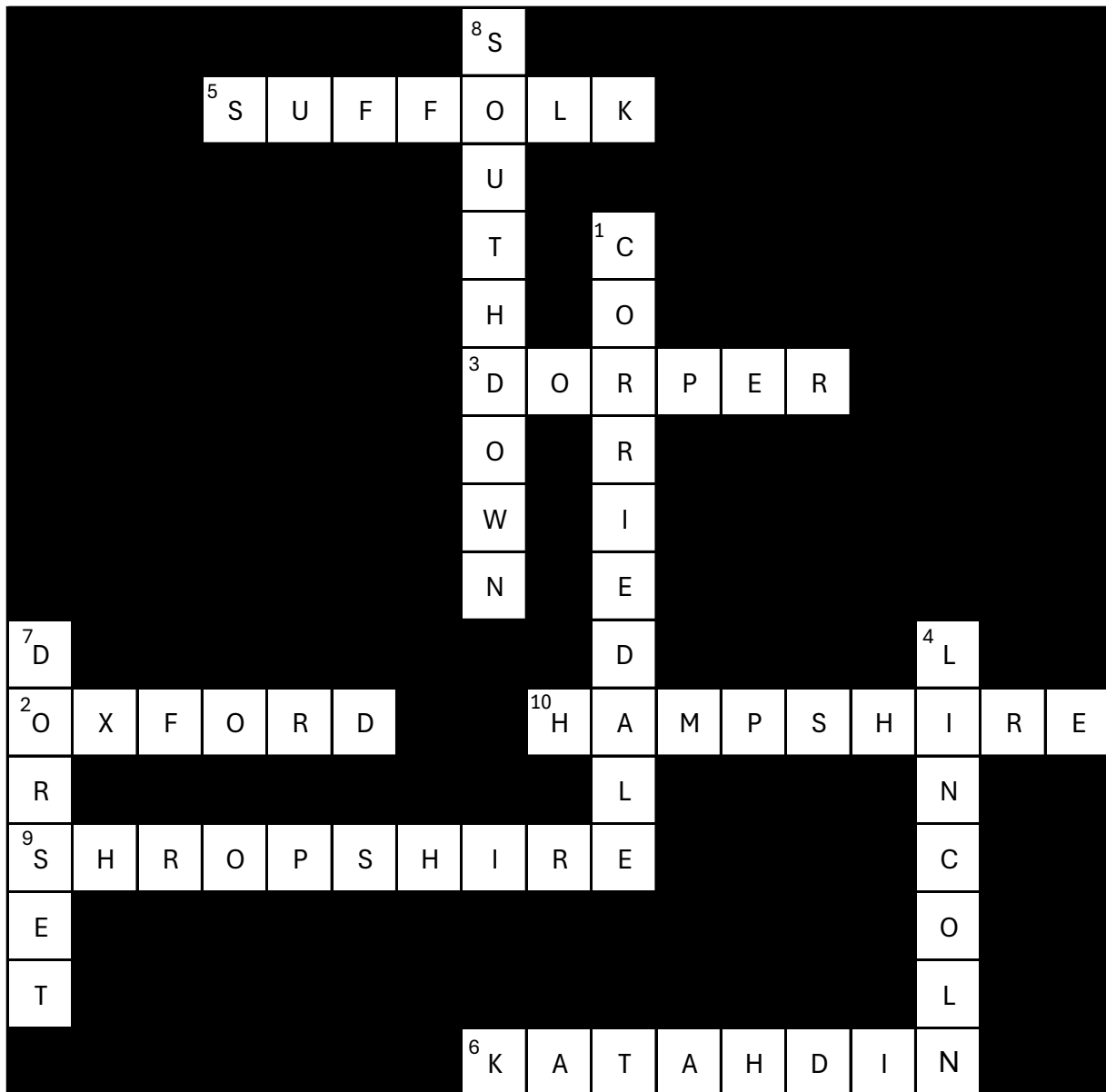


Sheep Breeds



1. White, open faced, originated from New Zealand, produces bulky, high-yielding fleeces
2. Large framed, black face breed established from crossing Cotswold x Hampshire
3. Terminal hair sheep from South Africa that is adaptable, parasite resistant, excellent mothers
4. Long woolled, colors vary from white, black, to gray, has "locks" of wool
5. Black faced, bell-shaped ears, slick legged, fast growing and high quality carcass
6. Hardy, low input, developed in the US by crossing St. Croix X Southdown X Hampshire X Suffolk
7. One of the most popular white face breeds in the US that can breed out of season
8. Medium framed and early maturing, terminal breed, mouse-colored features, triangle ears
9. Dual-purpose, result of crossing Southdown X Leicester X Cotswold breeds, black face with wool cap present
10. Large framed, fast growing, muscular, black face with wool present on poll, ears, and legs
