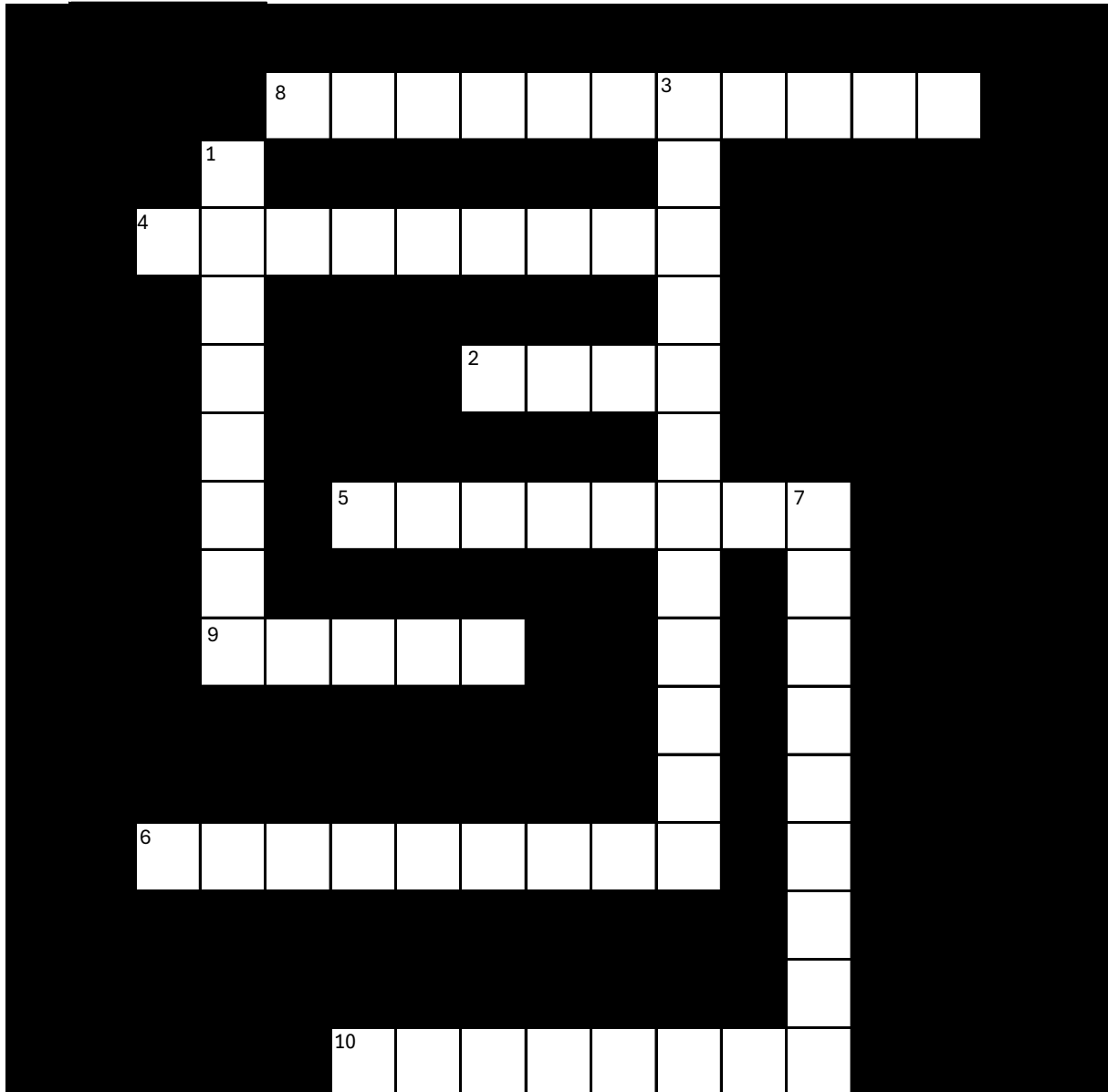
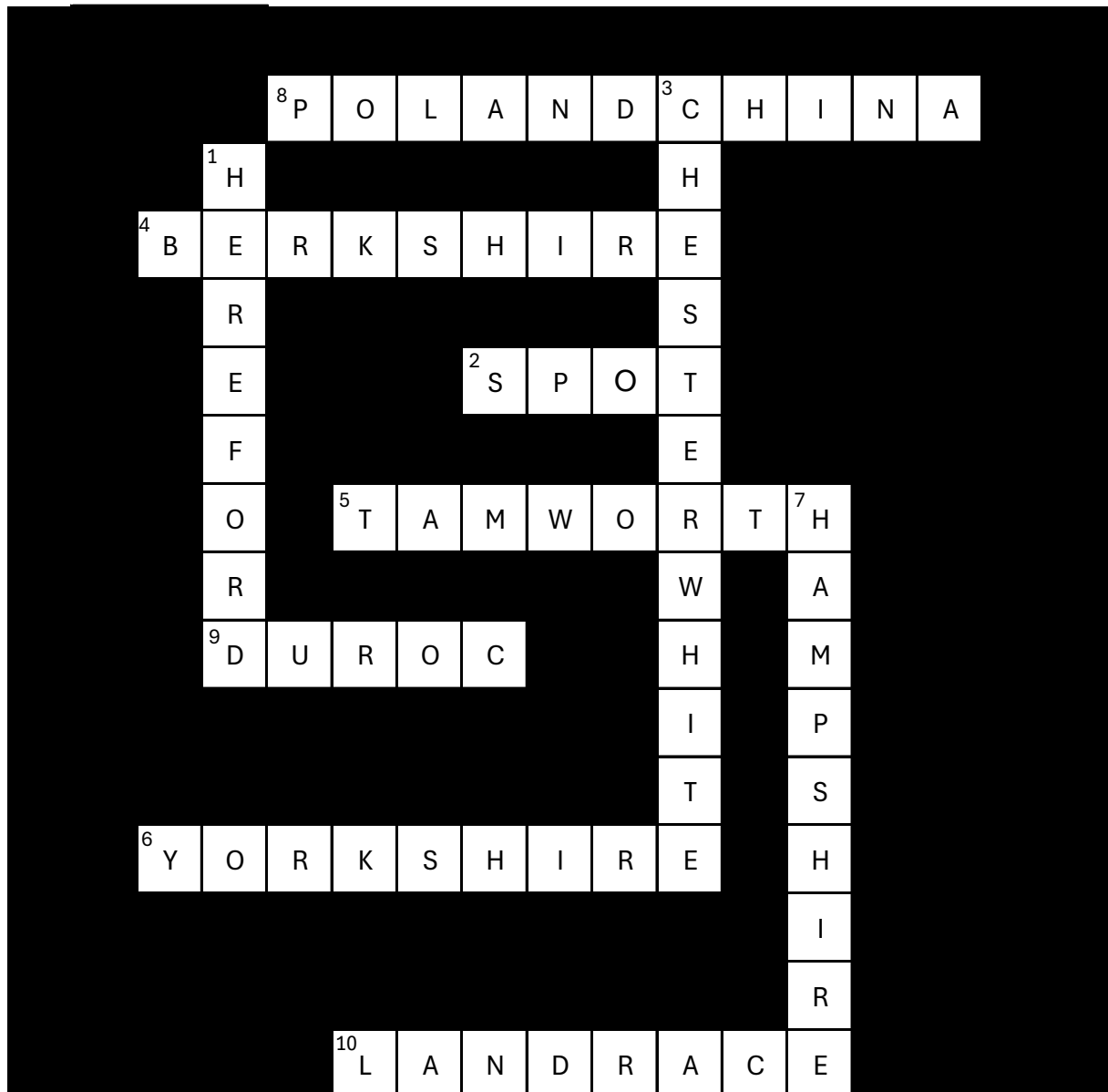


Swine Breeds

5. Breed origin from Ireland, golden red to dark red, erect ears, long snout, and short body, excellent mothering ability
6. "The Mother Breed", solid white with erect ears, prolific and sound structured
7. Terminal breed that is lean and muscular, black body with white belt and erect ears
